RULING OF THE COURT

7th day of July,2015 KILEO, J.A.:

When the matter was called on for hearing, Mr. Nassoro Katuga, learned Senior State Attorney appearing on behalf of the respondent Republic raised an issue of the competence of the application before us. He pointed out that the Notice of Motion was accompanied by an unsigned affidavit thus contravening the provisions of Rule 48 (1) of the Court of Appeal Rules, 2009. (The Rules). Mr. Katuga argued that an unsigned

affidavit is as good unsigned affidavit is as good as no affidavit and as such there being no affidavit the application remains to be incompetent and should be struck out.

Essentially the applicant did not challenge Mr. Katuga's averment. He merely lamented that he is in custody and every document is prepared for him by the authorities under whom he is kept in custody.

It is not disputed that the affidavit in support of the Notice of Motion instituting this application is not signed by the applicant. The signature of the deponent is one of the essential ingredients of any valid affidavit (see Director of Public Presentations versus Dodali Kapufi & Patson Tusalile — Cr. Application No 11 of 2008 (unreported). Much as we may sympathies with the applicants' predicament, as nightly pointed out by Mr. Katuga, ignorance of the law cannot be a ground for us to flout statutory provisions. An unsigned affidavit is indeed as good as no affidavit at all. This in effect means that the applicant's Notice of Motion was not supported by an affidavit in accordance with the dictates of Rule 48(1) of the Rules. Consequently, the application is found to be incompetent and for

hereby do.

It is accordingly so ordered.
