This is an application for leave to institute a suit against the respondents; the National Insurance Corporation of Tanzania Ltd, a specified public corporation and the Parastatal Sector Reform Commission. The application has been brought under S. 9 (1) of the Bankruptcy [Act Cap. 25 RE.2002], S.43 of the Public Corporations Act, [Cap. 257 RE.2002] and S.95 of the Civil Procedure Code [Cap. 33 RE.2002], A.
