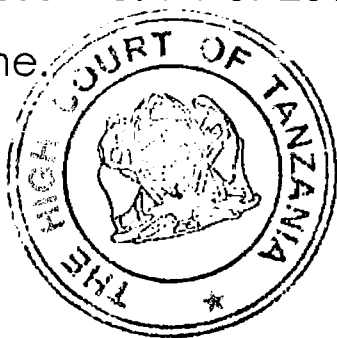
**Ebrahim, J.:**

The administrators of the estate of the late Mercy Anna Mengi, have filed the present application praying to be availed more time to file a complete and full inventory and accounts of the deceased. The reason for such prayer as outlined in the affidavit deposed by Nakazael Lukio Tenga, counsel for the applicants, and as expounded by Adv. Hamisi Mfinanga in his oral submission being that there is still the issue of appointment of the administrators of the estate of the late Reginald Mengi pending before this court which has effect of the decreed share of 35% of the late Mercy Anna Mengi.

The said shares have yet to be transferred to the estate of the late Mercy Mengi which emanates from the shares of the late Reginald Mengi as decreed during their livelihood in Matrimonial Cause No. 8 of 2015.

Having considered the prevailing circumstances and ensuring the full and true filing of the inventories and accounts of the late Mercy Anna Mengi; I find that this court is warranted to exercise its discretion and extend time for the proper and full administration of the deceased's estate.

That being said I accordingly accord parties six months from today to file the inventory and they should subsequently appear before this court on 18/06/2020 in respect of Probate Cause No. 74 of 2018 to report on further development of the same.
