RULING

MLACHA, J.

It came to the knowledge of the applicant, Hersi Warsane Mohamed, that his case, Land Case No. 67/2016 which is before me cannot proceed due to the lapse of the speed truck. With that in mind, he filed this application seeking extension of the speed truck. The respondent was duly served and entered an appearance through Advocate Samaha Salaa.

When the application was called for mention today, Ms. Samaha Salaa appeared and informed the court that he

has no objection to the application. In view of the lack of objection and on the strength of reasons contained in the affidavit of Mr. Mpaya Kamara, Counsel for applicant who was also present in court today, I see no reason as to why the application should not be granted. It is granted with the effect that a period of 4 months is extended within which Land Case No. 67 of 2016 should be heard and be finalized. I make no order as to costs.
