The applicant prays to be extended time to lodge notice of intention to appeal so that he can appeal against the decision of the District Court of Kilosa vide Economic Case No. 06 of 2016.

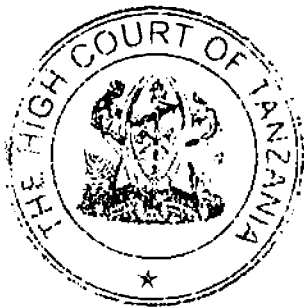
The Republic has no objection to the application. Counsel for the applicant has prayed to adopt the affidavit of the applicant in support of the application.

Going through the affidavit the applicant avers that he had once filed the requisite document in time, however when the matter was called for hearing of appeal there was no notice attached.

The law gives power this court to extend time to lodge notice of appeal where there are sufficient reasons. Considering the fact that the applicant is in prison and mostly have no control of following up his documents, I find that sufficient reason to extend time has been established.

I therefore allow the application. The applicant is availed 10 days (ten) to lodge his notice from the date he obtains a copy of this ruling.

Accordingly ordered.
