E. Kakolaki, J.

This is an application for grant of an extension of time within which to file an application for Revision. The application has been brought under Section 14 of the Law of Limitation Act [Cap. 89 R.E. 2002] supported by the affidavit sworn by **AARIF YUSUF SHARIF** the applicant. The application was not contested by the respondent who was expected to file the Counter Affidavit to that effect.

When the matter was called on for hearing before me the applicant was represented by **MR. DIMESH MAUJI** and **PETER ALOYCE** learned advocates while the respondent had

the services of **Mr. CHARLES SHIPANDE** learned Advocate. On raising up to address the court after preparedness of appellant's counsel to proceed with hearing Mr. SHIPANDE informed the court that the respondent was conceding to the application. But he prayed for waiver of costs the prayer which was not objected by Mr. DIMESH for the applicant.

Now that being the position this court has no reason to refuse the applicant's prayer which is grant of an extension of time within which to file the application for Revision of the decision of the District Court in Probate and Administration Cause No. 12 of 2018 at the District Court of Kinondoni. The applicant's application is therefore hereby granted. The time for the applicant to file the application for Revision of the decision of the District Court in Probate and Administration Cause No. 12 of 2018 at the District Court of Kinondoni is extended for 14 days from the date of this ruling. No order as to costs.

It is so ordered.
