JUDGMENT

MGONYA, J.

I have carefully gone through the record of this case and especially the Accused person cautioned statement and other expected witnesses to this matter.

Sincerely, I have encountered difficulty of holding straight responsible the Accused to this sad and unfortunate incident that caused the death of deceased one **ANNA JOSEPH @ HADIJA ALLY.**

The statements leaves no doubt that the accused herein is the one who was driving a car in that particular date and time of which the accused fell down from the same, the incident which occasioned her death.

However, I have failed to come across any convincing circumstances even a slight evidence that it was the accused who pushed the deceased from the car in which thereafter she met her creator.

Further, under those circumstances; in sentencing the accused for the offence of Manslaughter, I am of the view that, the three years he spent in remand prison are enough for him under the circumstances.

Further, upon all the mitigating factors from the accused person; and his respected counsel, I have decided to sentence him one year (1) suspended sentence on condition that he shall not breach or commit any offence of this nature within that period.

Otherwise, I proceed to **set the accused at liberty,** and **order his immediate release from remand prison upon** certifying the conditional discharge.

It is so ordered.
