The Applicants moved this court to extend time so that they lodge notice of intention to appeal and appeal accordingly. The Applicants were absent as they indicated not to be present during hearing of their application.

The Respondent Republic had the service of Mr. Nestory Mwenda learned, State Attorney. He did not oppose the application. He thought to be in the interest of justice if the Applicants are heard on merits in the intended appeal.

I have heard the learned State Attorney in his submission and had an opportunity to go through the joint affidavit of the three Applicants sworn on 15/10/2019. In essence, and as submitted by the Learned State Attorney, the affidavit has indicated sufficient cause for the granting of this application.

In that stance, time to lodge notice of intention to appeal is extended for ten (10) days from 12/5/2020. Time to appeal is also extended for forty five (45) days from the date of this ruling.
