

In the District Court of Kasulu at Kasulu the appellant unsuccessfully petitioned for divorce hence this appeal with several grounds.

At the hearing of this appeal the parties appeared in person and agreed to settle this appeal by entering into agreement on the dispute issues between them.

I adjourned the matter to give them time to settle.

Now they have reappeared before me and each submitted that they have settled and prayed me to register their agreement.



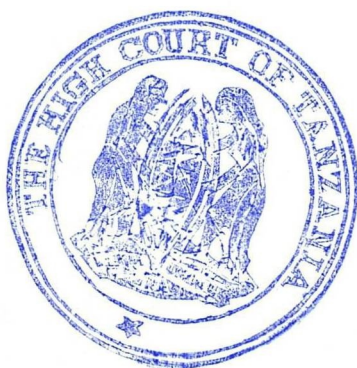


In the circumstances, it is hereby determined that this appeal has been amicably settled by the parties on agreement that a divorce decree be issued, equal distribution of their landed property with reference No. S. 2146 at Mkombozi street within Murusi Ward in Kasulu Town. It is further agreed that the dispute issue of the marriage one Sajad Hamimu shall be taken care by his mother the respondent who shall maintain him.

It is thus, ordered that the marriage between the parties has been broken down irreparably and the divorce decree is hereby issued. The landed property with reference No. S. 2146 be sold by parties on cooperation and the proceeds thereof shall be divided between them equally. The Respondent Imelda Johnstone Dosha shall take custody of the infact child Sajad Hamimu and shall maintain him.

As this appeal has ended by consensus of the parties themselves, I order no costs against any.

It is so ordered.
