MASABO,J:-

The application is for bail and is uncontested by the Republic. Upon examining the application and its supporting documents which include among others, an affidavit deposed by the applicant's counsel, a charge sheet in Economic Criminal Case No 54 of 2021 and the Ruling of this court in Misc. Criminal Application No. 165 of 2021, it is apparent that the offences facing the applicants are bailable and other persons jointly charged with the applicants in the said economic case have been admitted on bail.

Since I have not been presented with any materials inhibiting the grant of bail to the applicants, I admit them on bail on the following conditions.

- (1) Each of the applicant shall deposit in court a sum of Tshs. 21,740,625/= or in the alternative a title of an immovable property

with the equivalent value. The immovable property shall be within Dar es Salaam.

- (2) The applicant shall each sign a bond of Tshs. 21,740,625/=.
- (3) Each applicant must have 2 sureties who shall each sign a bond of Tshs. 1,000,000/=. The sureties must be resident in Dar es salaam with recognized residence and must produce National ID or letter of introduction from their respective local authority.
- (4) The applicant shall surrender travel document and shall not leave Dar es salaam without obtaining permission from the Resident Magistrate in charge of the Court of Resident Magistrate for Dar es Salaam at Kisutu.
- (5) The applicant shall continue attending their case.
- (6) All the conditions must be executed before the Resident Magistrate in charge of the Court of the Resident Magistrate for Dar es Salaam at Kisutu.

Order accordingly.
