In this Petition the Petitioner one Harun Idi Msangi has petitioned for letters of Administration to be appointed as administrator of the estate of the late Iddi Semvua Msangi, who died intestate at Hindu Mandal Hospital, Ilala District, Dar es Salaam Region on 6th September, 2020. The late Iddi Semvua Msangi is survived by one widow Raffic Said Walele and five sons namely Harun Idi Msangi, the Petitioner, Saidi Idi Msangi, Twalib Idi Msangi, Jaffer Idi Msangi and Senzige Idi Msangi.

He also left behind in his estate several properties estimated to be worth over Tshs. 200,000,000/=.

Upon filing of the Petition citation was made in the Government Gazette as well as two local newspapers widely circulated in the country. It is noted, until the date of hearing of this petition no caveat was filed by any person challenging appointment of the petitioner as administrator of the estate of the late Iddi Semvua Msangi.

I have perused the documents accompanying the petition and heard the submission from Ms. Magreth Kissoka learned counsel for the Petitioner, and satisfied that, the Petitioner has met all the requirements of the law and qualified to be appointed as administrator of the estate as prayed. It is from those grounds this court is granting the Petitioner's prayer by appointing Harun Idi Msangi as the Administrator of the Estate of the late Idi Semvua Msangi. The Petitioner will be subjected to guidance and directives of the court during his tenure in the office and he has to file in court inventory of the estate within six months of this appointment and the final account exhibiting distribution of the estate amongst the heirs.

It is so ordered.
