KAHYOZA. J.:

This is an application for extension of time to file an appeal. The record shows that the District Land and Housing Tribunal delivered its judgment on 19/11/2021 and certified the judgment on the 11/03/2022. Hence the judgment was available for collection from 11/03/2022.

The applicant was required to appeal within 45 days from the date of the judgment or from the date he was supplied with a copy of the judgment and decree. See Section 41(1) of the Land Dispute Act, [Cap. 216 R.E. 2019].

The Land Dispute Act is silent regarding the procedures for instituting an appeal from the District Land and Housing Tribunal, thus, the Civil Procedure Code, Act, [Cap. 33 R.E. 2019] (the CPC) has to apply. Rule 1(1) of Order XXXIX of the CPC provides that an appeal to the High Court must be

a companied by a copy a decree and judgment. For that reason, the applicant would not have appealed without the District Land and Housing Tribunal suppling him a copy of the decree and judgment.

It is undisputed that time spent to obtain a copy is excluded in computing time for lodging an appeal. See Section 19 of the Law of limitation Act, [Cap. 89 R.E. 2019]. The period of delay from 19/11/2021 to 11/03/2022 are excluded. It is on record that the appellant lodged the appeal on 22/04/2022. The appeal was lodged before the expiry of 45 days. It was lodged within time.

I find that the applicant lodged the appeal on time for reason there was no need to apply for extension of time. I strike out the application for extension of time as it is redundant. I make no order as to costs as the respondent did not appear.

It is so ordered.
