The ruling is in respect of a petition for administration of the estate of the late Ferdinand Rwechungura, whereby the petitioner Beatrice Ferdinand Rwechungura seeks the letters of administration of the said estate. The petitioner is the wife of the deceased, she averred that the late Ferdinand Rwechungura died intestate on **16th August 2021** at Muhimbili National Hospital-Mloganzila, Ubungo Dar es Salaam.

According to the petition in paragraph 1, the deceased was survived by six (6) heirs namely; Beatrice Ferdinand, Theofrida Ferdinand, Edmund Mushumbusi, Lilian Ferdinand, Macrina Ferdinand, and Francis Mushobozi. As it is reflected on the hearing of **07th June 2022**, the general citation has been complied with as published both in **Government Gazette** dated **13th May 2022** on **page 58** and **Mwananchi Newspaper** dated **25th March 2022** on **page 24**. The petition remains uncontentious as no caveat has been filed in objection. It is, therefore, the petitioner's prayer to be granted letters of administration of the deceased estate.

I have perused the petition and all necessary attachments and I have considered the submission of the petitioner, it is noted that the petitioner has complied with the citation order, and the petition is uncontentious for there being no caveat to date even after the publication of the general citation. Given compliance with all legal requirements, the petitioner **Beatrice Ferdinand Rwechungura** is hereby appointed as the **administratrix** of the estate of the late **Ferdinand Rwechengura**. In so doing, she shall exhibit full and correct inventory of the assets and credits falling under the estate of the deceased in court within **30 days** from the date of this ruling, final accounts shall also be filed within the

same period It is so ordered.
