In compliance with rule 31 of Probate Rules the reasons for delay in filing such petition is that ignorance of procedures to the extent that when their father died everything was left to the deceased widow, their mother. It is until her death after the death of their mother when the need to file this matter arose, resulting to this petition. The petition is supported by all the beneficiaries as signified by their written consent attached to this petition made in compliance of rule 71(1) of Probate Rules. The beneficiaries named herein include the following
