The ruling is in respect of a petition for administration of the estate of the late Dawson Rugoye Toyi, whereby the petitioner Frederick Rugoye seeks the letters of administration of the said estate. The petitioner is the son of the deceased, he averred that the late Dawson Rugoye Toyi passed away on 18th August 2021 at his residence in Kigamboni, Dar es Salaam.

It is on record that on **19th October 2021** he was also appointed by the family meeting to administer the said estate as the annexed minutes in the petition manifests.




According to the petition at page 1, the deceased was survived by six (6) heirs namely; Frederick Rugoye (son), Doris Rugoye (daughter), Saimon Rugoye (son), Rose Rugoye (daughter), Veronica Rugoye (daughter) and Nicolaus Rugoye (son). As it is reflected on the hearing of 02nd May 2022, general citation has been complied with as published both in Government Gazette dated 15th April 2022 at page 96 and Mwananchi newspaper dated 05th April 2022 at page 25. The petition remains uncontentious as no caveat has been filed in objection. It is, therefore, the petitioner's prayer that he be granted letters of administration of the deceased estate.

I have perused the petition and all necessary attachments. I have also considered the submission of the petitioner, it is noted that the petitioner has complied with the citation order, the petition is uncontentious for there being no caveat to date even after the publication of the general citation. In view of compliance with all legal requirements, the petitioner **Frederick Rugoye** is hereby appointed as the administrator of the estate of the late **Dawson Rugoye Toyi**. In so doing, he shall exhibit full and correct inventory of the assets and credits falling under the estate of the deceased in court within 6 months from the date of this ruling and final accounts within 12 months.

It is so ordered.
