RULING

OPIYO, J.

The ruling is in respect of a petition for administration of the estate of the late Michael Lulamso Mtega. The petitioners, Monica Benard Mgani and Fred Michael Mtega are seeking for letters of administration of the said estate. The petitioners who are widow and son of the deceased respectively aver that deceased died intestate on 22/12/2016. It is on record that both were recommended by clan members to jointly be appointed to administer these estates as per the minutes of the clan meeting held on 19th day of March 2017 annexed to the petition.

According to the petition page 2 the deceased was survived by 8 heirs namely; Monica Benard Mgani (wife) John Michael Mtega (son), Erick Michael Mtega (son), Freddy Michael Mtega (son), Danie Michael Mtega

(son), Davis Michael Mtega (son), Derick Michael Mtega (son) and vanessa Michael Mtega (Daughter)

It is their submission that court on publication of general citation has been complied with. General citation was published in both the Government Gazette dated 21/1/2022 page 63, issue no 3 and Mwananchi newspaper dated 10/1/2022 at page 17. The petition remain uncontentious as no caveat has been filed in objection. It is therefore, the petitioners prayer that both be granted letters of administration of the estate the deceased with undertaking to honestly, fairly and impartially administer the same.

Their submission is well supported with the petition presented before the court and its annexures. Upon the above proof of compliance and their petition remaining uncontentious todate, both petitioners Monica Benard Mgani and Freddy Michael Mtega are hereby granted letters of administration to jointly administer the estate of the late Michael Lulamso Mtega. In so doing, they shall exhibit full and correct inventory and of the assets and credits falling under the estate of the deceased in court within 30 days from the date of this order. Final accounts shall also be filed within the same period (i.e by 15th April 2022).
