RULING

MRUMA,J.

This is an application for bail. The Respondent/ Republic do not object bail to the accused persons D. 8294 S/SGT Godson Anael Kimambo and G.7322 SGT Said Omari Shekue Learned State Attorney who represents the Republic Ms. Florida Wensceslaus has requested the court to take into consideration the provisions of section 36(5) and (6) of the Economic and Organized Crime control Act RE 2019.

I have carefully perused the Applicant's application, the supporting affidavit sworn by Mr. Mashiku Sabasaba learned advocate for the Applicants and the submissions made by Ms Florida Wenscelaus, and I grant bail to the accused persons on the following conditions;

1. Each accused person shall secure two reliable societies who are ready and willing to execute a bail bond of Tshs 250, 000,000/= (Say Two Hundred and Fifty Million only) in the sum not cash.

2. The accused person shall sign a bail bond of Tshs 250,000,000/= (say two Hundred and Fifty Million) not cash.
3. The accused or any of his two securities shall deposition with the court cash or any other evidence of possession of a property (if immovable - a title deed) owned by him or the surety the value of which is not less than Tshs 250,000,000/= (Say Two hundred and Fifty Million Shillings – only).

For purpose of approval each surety shall produced to the Deputy Registrar his National Identity (ID) Card or an introduction letter from his Kitongoji executive officer or Kitongoji Chairman or a recognized and reputable employer.

All sureties shall be approved by the Deputy Registrar of this court and the records of these proceedings shall be certified and a copy thereof be transmitted to the trial court for record purpose. The accused shall attend their trial as shall be ordered from time to time.

Order accordingly.
