MIRINDO J:

Gidajuli Shauri alias Maiko has made a second application for extension of time to appeal to this Court. His first application was dismissed by Barthy J in Criminal Application No 18 of 2023 on 15th August 2023 on the grounds that he had not shown sufficient cause for extension of time. At the hearing of the application, the respondent represented by learned State Attorney Rhoida Kisinga raised a preliminary objection that this Court has no jurisdiction to



determine this second application. Gidajuli did not have much to say rather than emphasizing that he will continue to make the application until he succeeds.

I am satisfied that this application is incompetent and cannot be determined again by this Court and it is hereby struck out. The remaining remedy for Gidajuli is to appeal to the Court of Appeal subject to law.

It is so ordered.
