RULING


We have considered the prayers advanced for varying of the conditions for bail. We are also minded of the fact that the Respondents have not objected to the application. There is no doubt that at the time bail conditions were ordered on the 10th day of August, 2017, there were five accused persons. Therefore the principle of sharing considered this fact. It is also noted that the information filed in this Court, Economic Crime Case No. 1 of 2017, which is now pending committal proceedings has seven accused persons emanating from Misc. Economic cause No. 22 of 2017.

We find the addition of new accused persons provides circumstances for varying of the bail conditions especially, the first

and second conditions which considered the amount of the value of the alleged loss.

That being the case the conditions given by this Court upon admitting to bail the applicant Khalid Yusuph Hassan in Misc. Economic Cause No. 22 of 2017 are hereby varied as follows:-

1. Condition No. 3, 4, 5 and 6 to remain the same.
2. Condition No. 1 to read. The applicant Khalid Yusuph Hassan is to deposit Tshs. 901,355,016/= or immovable property of equivalent value to the amount of property in the charge. This amount has considered the principle of sharing there being seven accused person in Economic Crime Case No. 1 of 2017 undergoing Committal proceedings at RM's Kisutu.
3. The second condition is hereby varied to and read; The applicant to provide two reliable sureties who are to execute a bond of Tshs. 25,000,000/= each. One of the two sureties must be employed in Government Service or a Public Institutions.
