CONSENT JUDGMENT

MKEHA, J.

The plaintiff had filed a plaint claiming against the defendant among other things, payment of USD 145,000, interest of 8% per annum from 1st July, 2023 to the date of full payment, general damages and costs of the suit. However, before commencement of trial, the parties appended signatures to a deed of settlement in which the defendant has agreed to pay to the plaintiff and the latter has agreed to receive USD 166,528.68 being principal and interest of the whole claim.

Having satisfied myself that the deed of settlement has been freely entered into by the parties, consent judgment and decree is hereby entered in favour of the plaintiff for payment of USD 166,528.68.

The decretal amount shall be payable in 14 installments commencing from 30th October, 2023 to 24th November, 2024. Whereas the first 10 installments shall be of USD 5000 per month, the 11th and 12th installments shall be of USD 37,207 per each installment. The 13th installment shall be of USD 7,080 while the 14th installment shall be of USD 2,827.08. All the payments to be made via the plaintiff's account number 9120002348118 at Stanbic Bank Limited, Peninsular Branch.
