Applicant filed present application on 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2019. Raymond Swai, Advocate for the applicant appear twice on 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 and 12<sup>nd</sup> February, 2020. Since then, no appearance has ever been made for nine (9) months, despite several court orders. Applicant is the one who knowed the door of this court, requesting to be heard on an application for extension of time to file revision, yet no appearance for (9) nine months. This is not proper.
