Respondent **EMMANUEL TAGGI** filed dispute at CMA on 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2017, that was decided in his favour on 28<sup>th</sup> October, 2019. Same dissatisfied applicant, then, filed present revision on 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2019. Since following, no appearance has ever been made despite several court orders. That is not health for consumers of justice. Court orders has to be respected and adhered to. None compliance of court orders, not only is a disrespect but create chaos on entire administration of justice. Applicant by not appearing after filing the application eleven months ago, is to turn this court in to library of litigant court files. This cannot be accepted. This is four years old dispute since filed at CMA. None appearance by applicant for eleven month since filing, demonstrate lack of interest to prosecute the case, as submitted by respondent personal representative Hemedi Omari. Accordingly Rev. No. 916/2019 is dismissed for want of prosecution.
